

Basic Maritime Marksmanship

This course covers the fundamentals of marksmanship, proper handling and deployment of the handgun tactically in a maritime environment. The objective of this course is to immerse the student in the proper use, handling and overall functionality of the weapon system from their vessel. The student will learn all the basic concepts required to successfully deploy the weapon while at sea and the differences between shooting on land and water.
