The Motorcade Counter Assault course is designed to teach tactics and techniques required to survive an attack. This course will focus on techniques used for protecting dignitary's (CAT) during motorcade movements. Tactics and techniques taught during this course are combined with live fire exercises and realistic training scenarios designed to test and evaluate the student's ability to react under combat stress. The course will test the student's ability to apply the knowledge and skills learned during this course. Being physically fit is recommended for this course due to the high training tempo and physically challenging curriculum.
