

Rural Operation – Tactical Movement

The Rural Operations Tactical Movement course is designed to teach the student how to handle a violent subject in a rural environment. This course will focus on rural environment techniques used for moving through the woods as part of a tactical team and resolving armed conflicts or ambush situations. Tactics and techniques taught during this course will be combined with live fire exercises and realistic training scenarios designed to test and evaluate the student's ability to react as an individual or team member under combat stress. Being physically fit is recommended for this course due to the high training tempo and physically challenging curriculum.
