

Motor Yacht Defense & Security

This course teaches the fundamentals of close quarter self defense, reviews basic weapons handling, and marksmanship. Focusing on the maritime environment this course will include some lecture to prepare you or your crew on how to safely prevent unwanted boarding, minimize your appeal as a target, how to safely handle and fire handguns (or long guns) in the maritime environment. Additional information and consultation will be provided on how to supplement your weapons, your vessel, and your training with the use of night vision or thermal imagery. This will take your personal protection and vessel security to an unprecedented professional level.



Note* Basic Handgun is a prerequisite, Basic and Advanced Handgun is recommended prior to taking this course.
